WHAT DOES IT COST?

Because Omnilore is run by volunteeers, the cost is only \$90 per year, \$150 per couple, plus an OLLI fee of \$30 per person.

WHO RUNS OMNILORE?

Omnilore is governed by officers elected by the members and has no paid full-time staff. It is part of OLLI in the College of Extended and International Education at California State University, Dominguez Hills.

WHERE & WHEN DO THE GROUPS MEET?

All groups meet in Redondo Beach at the Franklin Center, 850 Inglewood Avenue, three blocks north of 190th Street. Sessions are held during weekdays in the morning and afternoon. Sessions are two hours long, divided into two one-hour segments with refreshments in between.

HOW OFTEN DO THE GROUPS MEET?

Each Study/Discussion Group meets twice a month for four months - a total of eight meetings. The Spring trimester starts January 1st, the Summer trimester begins May 1st, and the Fall trimester starts September 1st.

HOW MANY COURSES SHOULD I TAKE?

There is no limit on the number of courses a member may take. We recommend that new members start with only one to see the amount of time required.

ARE THERE OTHER ACTIVITIES?

You are entitled to attend a lecture series held twice a month during the Fall and Spring trimesters. It is held at the CSUDH campus and is provided by CSUDH professors on a given topic that is announced in the Omnilore curriculum. In addition, there are other Omnilore functions such as Forum luncheons, field trips (associated with a discussion group), hiking and certain special interest groups (e.g., the computer working group).

How Do I Join Omnilore?

Prospective members are required to attend an "Introducing Omnilore" meeting before joining, where Omnilore's procedures and member responsibilities are explained. These meetings are held prior to each trimester. Future meeting information is on our website, www.Omnilore.Org, or is obtained by using the contact information on the tear-off.
