WHAT DOES IT COST?

Because Omnilore is run by volunteers, the cost is only \$120 per year (or \$100, paperless option), which includes an OLLI fee of \$30 per person.

WHO RUNS OMNILORE?

Omnilore is governed by officers elected by the members and has no paid full-time staff. It is part of OLLI in the College of Extended and International Education at California State University, Dominguez Hills.

WHERE & WHEN DO THE GROUPS MEET?

All groups meet in Redondo Beach at the South Bay Adult School’s Edison Center, 3401 Inglewood Ave., at the intersection with Manhattan Beach Blvd. Sessions are held during weekdays in the morning and afternoon. Sessions are two hours long, including a break with refreshments.

HOW OFTEN DO THE GROUPS MEET?

Each Study/Discussion Group meets twice a month for four months - a total of eight meetings. The Spring trimester starts January 1st, the Summer trimester begins May 1st, and the Fall trimester starts September 1st.

HOW MANY COURSES SHOULD I TAKE?

There is no limit on the number of courses a member may take. We recommend that new members start with only one to judge the amount of time required.

ARE THERE OTHER ACTIVITIES?

You are entitled to attend three twice-a-month lectures held at the CSUDH campus and also in Manhattan Beach and Torrance, provided by CSUDH professors on topics that are announced on the CSUDH website. In addition, there are other Omnilore functions such as quarterly Forum luncheons, occasional S/DG field trips, and certain special interest groups (e.g., Hiking, Best-Sellers and the Computer Working Group).

HOW DO I JOIN OMNILORE?

Prospective members are required to attend an “Introducing Omnilore” meeting before joining, where Omnilore’s procedures and member responsibilities are explained. These meetings are held prior to each trimester. Future meeting information is on our website, www.Omnilore.Org, or is obtained by using the contact information on the tear-off.
